Rules for the Willows Ponds and Common Areas

Resident Access: The ponds are reserved for the exclusive use of The Willows residents. Guests are welcome, but residents must always accompany their guests when fishing.

Catch-and-Release Fishing: Fishing is allowed on a catch-and-release basis only. Please handle the fish with care and promptly return them to the water to ensure the health of our aquatic life.

Prohibited Activities: To maintain the safety and enjoyment of all residents, activities such as swimming, wading, ice skating, hockey, or any other water-based recreation are strictly prohibited in the ponds.

Dog Walking Etiquette: Residents walking their dogs must be mindful of others. Dogs must be always leashed, and owners are required to clean up after their pets. Pet waste bags have been generously provided at all bench locations for your convenience, so please help keep our community clean.

Golf Cart Use: For the safety of residents, the use of golf carts or other motorized vehicles is prohibited on sidewalks and pathways.

Community Cleanliness: Please ensure that all trash is disposed of properly in designated waste bins when using the ponds and common areas. Your cooperation helps maintain the beauty and cleanliness of The Willows for everyone.

Feeding Wildlife: Feeding ducks, geese, or other wildlife is strongly discouraged. Studies show that feeding can disrupt their natural diets and negatively impact their health. Additionally, overfeeding has contributed to a significant increase in their population, resulting in excessive waste that creates unsanitary conditions on sidewalks. We kindly ask that feeding be limited to occasional small quantities provided by children.
